

NEANN Poster Abstract Guidelines

Presentation for Spring Regional Conference: March 24, 2024

Due Date for Abstract Submissions: January 31, 2024 (11:59 p.m.)

Notification of Acceptance: February 12, 2024

Purpose and Audience:

The NEANN poster session will provide an opportunity for nurses in any role (students, nurse residents, staff, education, administration, etc.), as well as nurse practitioners and nursing students to present projects and/or scholarly work relevant to the NICU at a regional conference.

Suggestions for Poster Topics

- Quality Improvement initiatives (in progress or completed)
- Evidence-Based Practice projects (in progress or completed)
- Research projects (in progress or completed)
- Education posters

Requirements:

- Posters must be relevant to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit
- At least one presenter should be available to attend NEANN's annual conference on Sunday, March 24, 2024, to showcase the poster and dialogue with conference attendees during the designated poster session.
- Each presenter will be required to provide 3 goals/objectives as practice "take-aways."
- Abstracts should be 500 words or less, formatted in Microsoft Word. *Word count does not include title, authors and affiliations*
- Abstracts should be formatted to include the following headings:
Title, Authors and Affiliations, Introduction, Purpose, Methods, Results, Conclusions

Title: *Create a title that conveys what the project is about – consider something that is “eye catching” and will make people want to stop and ask questions or learn more.*

Authors and Affiliations: *Names of people involved in the poster and their institution(s).*

Information of primary presenter (who will attend NEANN to present): *Name, title, credentials and email.*

Information of co-presenter (if applicable): *Name, title, credentials and email.*

School and address if student presenter (if applicable):

Introduction: *Present background information related to your project/study.*

Purpose: *What was the reason you did this project/study?*

Methods: *What did you do? Who was involved?*

Results: *What did you find? Report of results, data and findings.*

Conclusions: *What does this mean for patients/nurses/etc., as applicable*
